He has also amassed much external examination experience, including work at the University of Johannesburg, South Africa, the University of Northern NSW and University of Newcastle in Australia.

The Trustees have made me feel very welcome and the activities they get involved with, particularly the bursary scheme, are activities that are very close to my heart”, Keith said.
